Reporting UPDATE

As of October 4, 2021, the college has awarded an additional \$25,426 to 15 students. These students had qualifying expenses such as tuition, fees, food, housing, technology, childcare expoenses, medical expenses. To date, we have awarded a total of \$562,464 and have \$141,286 available to award.

—

On May 27, 2021, the college awarded \$200,000 to 307 students. Of this, 249 students were awarded \$161,014. They were Pell Grant eligible students enrolled in Spring 2021 and did not receive an award previously. Their award was based on their EFC and Enrollment Status.

The remaining \$38,986 was awarded to 58 Summer 2021 students with balances.

To date, we have awarded \$537,083 of the \$703,750. We have \$166,712 to be awarded.

Belmont Abbey College has received \$2,247,933 in CRRSAA HEERF II funding from the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund on January 19, 2021. The college has signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement. The college will award the \$703,750, of the funds received to students as Emergency Financial Aid Grants. We estimate there are about 1400 eligible students.

An initial award was made on February 12, 2021. We awarded 164 Title IV eligible students, a total of \$299,062. On March 11, 2021, an additional 43 students were awarded a total of \$37,976.

The students were awarded based on an EFC and spring balance as of the review date. Students were notified via their college email that they were awarded Emergency Financial Aid Grants as part of the CRRSAA HEERF II.
