This prestigious recognition highlights the college's commitment to developing compassionate, competent healthcare professionals grounded in faith and ethics. CCNE's accreditation is effective retroactively from February 28, 2024, until December 2029. At the end of the term, CCNE will reaffirm the upholding of its accreditation standards through another site visit.
